Ilia Durovic, a US citizen, was a student of the late Geshe Rabten Rinpoche, who was the Counsellor in Religious Affairs for HH the Dalai Lama. Ilia studied Buddhist philosophy under Geshe Rabten's direction and was his personal French translator in Switzerland. Ilia also translated into French for His Holiness the Dalai Lama in Geneva and was ordained by His Holiness. Because of his very good knowledge of Buddhist Philosophy, the then disciplinarian of Sera Je Monastery (second only to the Abbot of the monastery) and his teacher decided that he should be allowed to enter directly into the fourth year of studies at Sera Je, an exceptional decision made at the time. Ilia also successfully passed a debate examination in Tibetan in front of the whole monastery (3,500 monks), the only Westerner to ever have done so. He then studied three further years at Sera Je, completing an in depth study of Buddhist Philosophy. Ilia brings into his seminars a huge list of academic achievements, as well as credentials from many world famous Lamas that he has translated for over many many years. He has studied Buddhism for over three decades and has lived his life according to the teachings.
